

NEW PA RESIDENT

Steps you need to take in order to obtain your new PA Drivers License and PA Title/ Registration:

Drivers License: You are supposed to obtain a new PA DL within 60 days of establishing a PA residency. You must obtain your Drivers License BEFORE doing any title or registration paperwork

Step 1: You will need to bring with you [Proof of Residency & ID](#) along with your Social Security Card.

Step 2: You will need to take a Vision Screening test and complete a [DL180R](#).

Step 3: You will need to surrender your out-of-state license.

Step 4: Appear in person at a PA Drivers Licensing Center with the above paperwork.

Title & Registration: You are supposed to make an application for a new PA title and registration within 20 days of establishing PA residency. We can complete/process this portion for you.

Step 1: You will need your out of state title (if financed and you do not have the title, contact us immediately so that we can begin the process of the lienholder releasing the title to us on your behalf).

Step 2: [Proof of Pennsylvania Insurance](#) will be required.

Step 3: Obtain a VIN tracing of the VIN # off the vehicle or print out a photo of the VIN. This is usually located on the top of the dashboard closest to where the inspection stickers would go. If the vehicle which is being titled is the one you are bringing with you to get the registration for, we can verify the digits ourselves if the vehicle is present, in which case a tracing would not be necessary.

Step 4: You will need to bring with you your current/valid PA Drivers License.

Step 5: Bring all of the above items to our location and we will be able to process them for you and you will walk out with a new PA license plate and registration. The new PA title will be mailed directly to you (as long as you have no lien on the vehicle) within 4-6 weeks directly from PENNDOT.

Fees due at time of service- Acceptable forms of payment :Check or Cash.

If paying by check, you will need 2 checks, one made payable to Commonwealth of PA and the other to the notary.
