

## Mulches



**Black mulch** is dyed with a vegetable-based color, harmless to people, pets, plants and the soil. It is made up of recycled hardwood. One yard of black mulch is equivalent to 4-5 wheelbarrows full, 15 bushels or 13-14 bags of our two cubic foot bagged mulch. Available bulk or bagged.



**Brown Mulch** is dark brown in color. It is dyed with a vegetable-based color, harmless to people, pets, plants and the soil. It is made up of recycled hardwood. One yard of black mulch is equivalent to 4-5 wheelbarrows full, 15 bushels or 13-14 bags of our two cubic foot bagged mulch. Available bagged or bulk.



**Red Mulch** is dyed with a vegetable-based color, it is harmless to people, pets, plants and the soil. It is made up of recycled hardwood mostly from pallets. One yard of Red mulch is equivalent to 4-5 wheelbarrows full, 15 bushels or 13-14 bags of our two cubic foot bagged mulch. Available bagged or bulk.



**Cushion wood** goes through a unique grinding and screening process, meets ADA requirements, exceeds CPSC guidelines and meets required ASTM standards. Perfect for use in parks, schools and day care centers, Cushion-Wood drains water well, provides a naturally attractive appearance that delivers long-lasting quality and durability, and provides shock absorbency. Not recommended for landscape beds with plant material it compacts to much not allowing for air and water to get down to plants roots. Available only in bulk.

## Mulches



**Cedar mulch** is light golden brown as it decomposes it will turn a silvery gray. Cedar mulch naturally resists insects. One yard of cedar mulch is equivalent to 4-5 wheelbarrows full, 15 bushels or 13-14 bags of our two cubic foot bagged mulch.

**Hardwood Mulch** is dark brown in color. This mulch becomes alkaline as it breaks down, benefiting all but those plants that need a lot of acid, such as azaleas, rhododendron and holly.

**Pine Bark Mulch** comes from several trees including pine and fir. The consistency is made up of chunky bark and wood fines and doesn't compact. This is the most popular mulch, very attractive and lasts the longest. Plants that thrive in acidic soil, like azaleas and rhododendrons, love pine bark mulch, which also provides a high level of aluminum.

**Cypress mulch** is light golden brown. Most plants benefit from the added nutrients cypress mulch provides. Some organic mulches change the pH of the soil as they decompose, such as pine needles and pine bark, which add acid to the soil, lowering the soil's pH. Cypress mulch is neutral and does not change the soil's pH level as it decomposes. Naturally repels insects. Only available in bags.
