

Evergreen Shrubs



Arborvitae 'Emerald Green'
Emeral green foliage with compact pyramidal form. Densely branched. Holds color well through winter

Ht: 10-12' Sp: 4'



Arborvitae 'Green Giant'
Upright pyramidal evergreen with deep green foliage. Very fast growing, with a single leader. Does well in part shade.

Ht: 35-50' Sp: 15-25'



Arborvitae 'Mr. Bowling Ball'
A unique, compact, perfectly global Arborvitae with dense, fine-textured, soft, sage-green foliage.

Ht: 2-3' Sp: 2-3'



Arborvitae 'Degroote's Spire'
Tall, narrow form. Rich green foliage takes on purple cast in winter. Twisted texture on pyramidal form tolerates shearing for a more tailored look.

Ht: 20-30' Sp: 4-6'



'Boxwood 'Green Velvet'
A dense, low hedge the foliage retains its rich green color

Ht: 4' Sp: 4'



'Boxwood 'Green Mountain'
An upright grower with bright green leaves that retain their color through winter.

Ht: 5' Sp: 3'



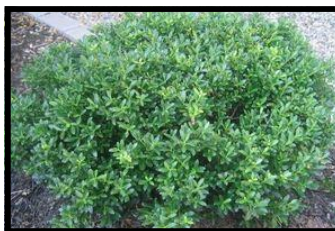
Boxwood 'Green Gem'
Small, lush, green mound, slow-growing, requires little pruning. Excellent for hedges and borders.

Ht: 2' Sp: 2'



'Juniper 'Blue Star'
Slow growing evergreen with beautiful silvery blue color. Grows in a dry sandy soil.

Ht: 1-3' Sp: 1-4'



Holly 'Soft Touch'
Dense with soft, glossy green leaves. Rounded growth with a spreading compact habit an the plant ages.

Ht: 3-4' Sp: 5-6'



Holly Royal Family (Prince/Maid)
Self pollinating variety Red berries in the fall with a small white flower in the spring

Ht: 8-10' Sp: 6-8'



Yews 'Densiflorus'
Dense, low, spreading habit. Medium-dark foliage with red berries in fall. Excellent for hedges and borders.

Ht: 3-4' Sp: 4-6'



Yews 'Brownii'
Densely rounded habit. Easily pruned and can be maintained at any height. Dark green foliage, bronzes during winter. No berries

Ht: 8-10' Sp: 6-12'



'Yew 'Hicksii'
Long upright branches forming a narrow, columnar habit. Dark green needles contrast nicely with bright red berries. Popular choice for tall hedge.

Ht: 1-3' Sp: 1-4'
