Phone books



Newspapers, magazines, brochures & inserts (no plastic bags, do not tie & bundle)



Corrugated cardboard & paper bags (flattened)



Greeting cards, regular & junk mail



Cardboard beverage carriers



Paperboard boxes (cereal, pasta & tissue)



Follow Guidelines Carefully

NO NEED TO REMOVE:

Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs

Glass bottles & jars



File folders, office paper

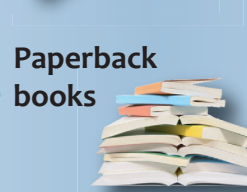
- Scrap metal
- VHS/VCR tapes
- Plastic bags
- Needles or syringes
- Window panes, mirrors, ceramics & Pyrex dishware
- Stickers or address label sheet waste
- Plastics other than those listed
- Electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)
- Paint, pesticides, oil & cleansers
- Organic material and food waste
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- Styrofoam or paper-to-go containers
- Plastic caps
- Hard cover books / 3-ring binders

Please flatten all cardboard boxes. Empty and rinse all containers. Don't shred more paper than necessary. Shred confidential information only. Collection containers size is limited to 32 gallons (50 lbs). Use more than one container if necessary.
