**REGISTRATION:** DAY OF THE EVENT; 9AM – 5:00 PM SATURDAY AT STAR ARMS, OR UP TO 96 HOURS PRIOR BY PHONE DURING STAR ARMS BUSINESS HOURS (9AM – 6PM). YOU CAN PAY WITH CREDIT CARD OVER THE PHONE.

**CHECK IN:** SUNDAY 12 PM SHARP (NO EXCEPTIONS)

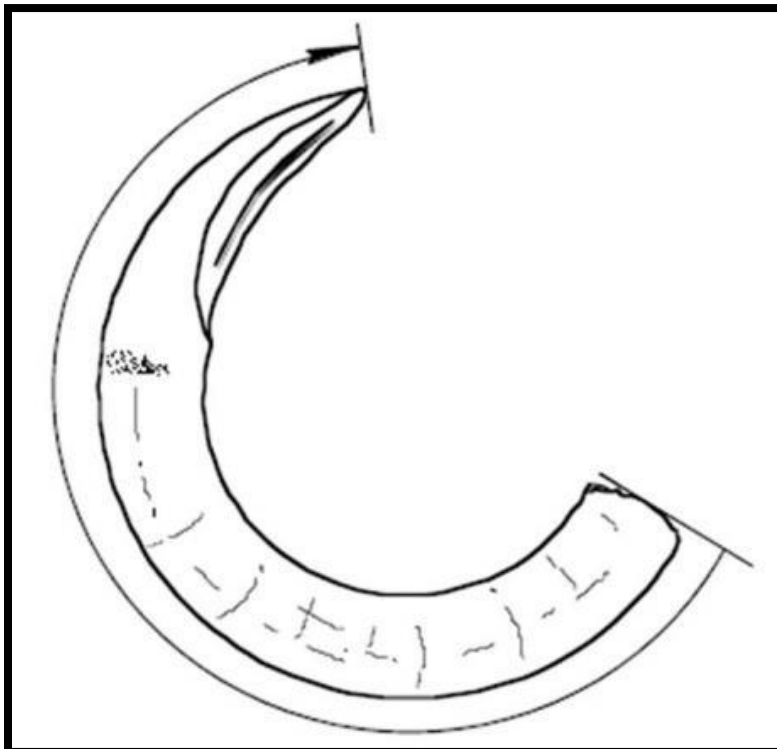
**ENTRY FEES: \$100.00 PER TEAM, UP TO A 4 PERSON TEAM**  
\$25 OF THIS FEE WILL GO TO STAR ARMS. THIS FEE IS TO DEFER THE COST OF POLYGRAPHS.

**JACKPOTS:** HEAVIEST THREE HOG STRINGER, LONGEST CUTTERS (\$25.00 EA)

**CONTEST BOUNDARIES:** **STATE WIDE** MUST FOLLOW STATE LAWS!!!!

1. The contest is open to the entire State of Texas and hunting hogs only in Texas.
2. Must be signed up by April 21<sup>st</sup> by noon to hunt!
3. You can win all 3 pots – main event pays 75% of total entries (split 60%/40% to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place)! If less than 6 teams have signed up, there is no 2<sup>nd</sup> place prize for main event. The other 25% goes to offset cost of polygraph.
4. Jackpots pay 100% of pool (minus admin / poly fee). Jackpots classes include: 1) heaviest three hog stringer and 2) longest cutters. Teams must sign up for main event to participate in jackpots. Jackpots are optional. Total fee for all three will be \$150.00.
5. Four (4) Man Team Maximum – No Trapping! Must be hunted from the ground in regulation with TPWD with a valid Texas hunting license.
6. Teams may split up 2-2, but must be within line of sight of each other. NO hunting with other teams! No pooling of hogs! Your team must kill their own hogs, no one else!
7. A team member from 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> place of the main event (heaviest hog) and one jackpot winner team member will be randomly chosen for a polygraph. Refusal to submit to a polygraph will cause forfeiture of the entire team. Alcohol consumption before a poly may skew results and will result in the entire team being disqualified.
8. The Contest starts Saturday, April 21, 2018 at sunup – NO EARLY STARTS!
9. Weigh-In is at Star Arms (archery shed), 6688 S. US HWY 377, Stephenville, Texas 76401. You can weigh your hogs 10AM and 12PM, Sunday, April 22, 2018. You must be inside the Star Arms gate by 12PM on April 22<sup>nd</sup>. And yes it's more of a 24 hour hunting contest. Just have to be at the weigh in between those times!
10. For the purpose of this hunt, hogs are defined to be feral, free ranging, wild hogs which have not been previously held, trapped, pen raised, and released for the purpose of being hunted in this or any other contest and must not have been hunted from a hog proof fence. They must have the characteristics of a wild hog.
11. All Hogs Must Be DEAD in order to be weighed or measured! Hogs must be intact (hoof weight) and NOT gutted. Hogs showing signs of traps, snares or dogs will not be judged.
12. NO Barrowed Hogs. Boars must have testicles to be judged for main event or jackpots.
13. Any contestant found to be cheating or attempting to cheat will cause the disqualification to his / her team and forfeiture of any and all entry fees. Cheating will also cause that contestant to be banned from all future events.
14. In the event of a tie, the hog who was weighed/measured first will be declared the winner.
15. You are responsible for the disposal of all wild hogs after they are weighed.
16. All Federal and State Game Laws must be followed. Hunting license and state ID are required at weigh in and for polygraph.
17. Longest cutters will be measured from the edge of the gums, to the tip of the tooth along the longest arch, then combined with the other cutter (see diagram). Only lower canine teeth (cutters) on boars will be measured for this jackpot. Cutters that are broken, missing or have been loosened will not be evaluated regardless of cause. Measurements will be to the closest 1/8".
18. Judges will have final decision in all disputes.

DIAGRAM, CUTTER MEASUREMENT

the lower tusks, especially in boars, are locally called cutters, because these teeth tend to be very sharp at the tips, and as such, are used by the animal for cutting a rival, prey, or predator. The lower tusks are called cutters. These are the dangerous tusk, because they are sharpened against the upper tusks. The upper tusks are called whetters (taken from the term “whetstone,” which is a sharpening stone used for knives and other cutting tools), because their primarily function is to sharpen the lower tusks called cutters.
