

## Patio 500 Care & Cleaning

One of the best ways to keep your awning fabric looking good and to delay the need for deep or vigorous cleaning is to hose off the awnings on a monthly basis with clear water. This practice will help prevent dirt from becoming deeply imbedded in the fabric and eliminate the need for more frequent vigorous cleanings. In most environments, a thorough cleaning will be needed every two to three years. When it is time for a cleaning, the fabric can be cleaned while still on the awning frame. We do not recommend using a power/pressure washer. That is not necessary to clean the fabric. Please see the cleaning instructions for proper care.

When cleaning Patio 500 fabric, it is important to observe the following:

- Always use a mild detergent (i.e. Dawn Dish Detergent)
- Water should be cold to lukewarm, never more than 100 degrees.
- Air dry only.
- Brush off loose dirt.
- Hose down.
- Prepare cleaning mixture of water and mild detergent.
- Use a soft bristle brush to clean.
- Rinse thoroughly.
- Air dry.

## General Care for Patio 500 fabric:

- Hose down awnings regularly and allow the fabric to dry completely. Mildew will grow on any accumulated dirt or foreign materials and eventually penetrate and damage fabrics.
- Keep awning underside clean by brushing with a clean household broom.
- Keep all shrubs and vines clear of awnings as many plants contain acids harmful to fabrics.
- Repair any small rips or tears promptly.
- Do not overspray fabric with insect repellents as some insecticides will stain fabric
- Do not use charcoal, gas or electric grills beneath awnings.
- Do not permit leaves, twigs or other organic debris to remain on awnings.
