## **Range Safety Rules**

## ALL FIREARMS WILL BE HANDLED IN A SAFE MANNER AT ALL TIMES

- 1. ALL patrons will watch the safety training video PRIOR to entering the range.
- 2. Liability waiver will be signed by every patron prior to entering the range.
- 3. SAFTEY GEAR will be worn at ALL ALL TIMES (Eye and Ear protection). "Sunglasses of any type are NOT allowed on the range".
- 4. NO ONE IS ALLOWED FORWARD OF THE BOOTH FOR ANY REASON. If you drop something forward of the booth (RED LINE ON THE FLOOR) the patron will contact the Range Safety Officer (RSO) (you may pick up your brass on your side of the red line, any brass forward of the booth becomes property of the High Caliber Training Center and Indoor Range (HCTC).
- 5. ALL firearms will remain in their case until the patron reaches the firing line (yellow line on the floor).
- 6. No firearm will be allowed on the range that exceeds the specifications of the range trap.\*
- 7. ALL firearms will be grounded with the chamber open and up; or cylinder open and muzzles pointed down range when not being fired.
- 8. There will be NO firing from a holster unless in participation of a sanctioned class or match.
- 9. In the event of any malfunctions on the range it is the patron's responsibility to clear the malfunction. If assistance is needed, the patron will raise their weak hand, keeping the muzzle pointed down range, and ask for the assistance of the RSO on duty.
- 10. When finished firing, the patron will unload and ensure the firearm is clear before encasing the firearm and moving behind the firing line (yellow line on the floor).
- 11. Damaging any part of the range (intentionally or not) is the fiduciary responsibility of the customer to repair and may result in exclusion from the range.
- 12. ANY PATRON OR EMPLOYEE MAY CALL A CEASE FIRE AT ANY TIME IT IS NECESSARY. Upon declaring a cease fire, ALL patrons will unload and ground their firearm.
- 13. NO PATRON WILL RESUME FIRING UNTIL A RSO HAS GIVEN THE COMMAND THAT THE FIRING LINE IS SAFE, CLEAR AND READY TO RESUME FIRING!
- 14. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- \* Range specs will be determined based on the specific range system purchased and approved by the vendor for the specific range.

Violation of any of the following Range Safety Rules WILL result in IMMEDIATE and PERMANENT REMOVAL from the range:

- 1. ANY accidental discharge that occurs behind the firing line (yellow line on the floor).
- 2. ANY patron going forward of the RED LINE located in front of the booth.
- 3. ANY injury to another patron as a direct result of any unsafe firearm handling.
- 4. ANY patron suspected of using any alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or misuse of prescription drugs while on the range.
- 5. Leaving the firing line with a loaded firearm.
  - \*This does not apply to a Licensed Concealed Carry Individual or LEO who has made their firearm ready and has concealed it in a safe manner.
