SUPPRESSOR CHECKLIST/TIMELINE

- Customer selects their suppressor and pays in full
 - If in-stock at Top Gun Shooting Sports, Form 4 is filled out
 - If ordered from Manufacturer/Distributor and item is in-stock, Form 3 must be filled out by Man/Dist (2-6 week wait) before it can be shipped to Top Gun
 - If not in-stock at Manufacturer/Distributor, must wait until it is produced, then wait for Form 3 before being shipped

- Once suppressor is at Top Gun, Form 4 is partially filled out in duplicate.
 - Customer takes partially filled out Form 4 to local Law Enforcement Agency for Chief/Sheriff's signature – this states that there is no reason that would disqualify the individual from owning a suppressor. Fingerprint cards will also be taken at this time.
 - Customer returns to Top Gun with signed Form 4 along with a check for \$200 made out to "BATFE" for the Tax Stamp and two (2) fingerprint cards

- Top Gun Shooting Sports finalizes the Form 4 and submits along with \$200 check and two (2) fingerprint cards.

- Wait for approval – could take anywhere from 3-12 months.

- Approval (or Denial) arrives at Top Gun Shooting Sports
 - A Top Gun employee will notify the customer that their approval has arrived, and their suppressor is ready to be picked up

- Customer comes to Top Gun Shooting Sports to complete Form 4473 and take possession of Suppressor

Second Option – If local Law Enforcement Agency will not sign off on Form 4, the customer can create a "Living Trust". This will involve either attorney fees or legal software, but it allows you to bypass the Chief Law Enforcement Officer Signature and fingerprint requirements of Form 4, and allows multiple people to use and possess the suppressor.
