Bingo Rules

1. No one under age 21 may be on the premises.
2. The actual letter and number on the ball drawn or freely awarded is official. Flashboards and monitors are provided as a convenience.
3. NDAD may cancel bingo at its discretion.
4. A player must shout BINGO on the last number called and an on duty NDAD gaming employee must hear you before the caller utters any sound of the letter or number of the next ball for your bingo to be valid. Once a caller closes the game no more bingos will be honored.
5. Multiple winners will split. For example, if 2 people bingo, they will receive 1/2 of the prize level they are playing. A player may only have one winning pattern per face, although you may have multiple winning different faces per game on one card.
6. The United States Internal Revenue Service Rules require that U.S. citizens sign a W2-G Form upon winning \$1200 or more in a single bingo game. Regulations require NDAD to withhold 30% of Canadian or other foreign winnings upon identification of any form of gambling winnings, except table games, regardless of amount won.
7. If a player attempts to falsify or falsifies a record of win, the prize is forfeited.
8. A bingo card is void if it is taken outside the gaming area.
9. NDAD employees, who do not work at this site, may play all games.
10. On Game 7, if blackout is achieved on or before jackpot number, the winner will choose an envelope from the lowest level of the pyramid to determine their prize. If the "UP" envelope is drawn, the winner will choose from the next level up until their prize is determined. When a prize is drawn, the envelope will not be replaced until the Main \$2,100 prize is won. "UP" cards for each row will be replaced until all \$ envelopes are gone.
11. All percentage consolations are calculated after deducting gaming tax.
